

Genre Review: Fables, Fairy Tales, and Fractured Fairy Tales

Fable

- main characters are animals (that act like humans)
- teaches a moral at the end of the story
- Examples: Lion and Mouse, Tortoise and Hare

Fairy Tale

- includes fantasy/magical people
- often includes royalty
- Examples: Cinderella, Little Red Riding Hood

Fractured Fairy Tales

- different versions of classic fairy tales
- usually funnier than the original
- Examples: Goldilocks and The Three Dinosaurs, The True Story of the Three Little Pigs

- Students should be able to label a story (that we have read in class) with the correct genre- Fable, Fairy Tale, or Fractured Fairy Tale.
- Students will listen to a fable during the test and pick out the moral of the story.
